


UNIT 2. SESSION 1

Andrew Brought His Brother to Jesus

JOHN 1:6-8,28-42

John the Baptist was teaching people about Jesus. John was a man sent from God to tell people that God's Son, Jesus, was coming.

One day John saw Jesus coming toward him. John said, "Here is God's Son, who takes away



the sin of the world. This is the one I told you about." The next day, John was standing with two disciples when he saw Jesus again. "Look" he said. John wanted them to know that Jesus, God's Son, was there.

The two disciples heard John's words and decided to follow Jesus. Jesus noticed that they were following Him.

"What are you looking for?" asked Jesus.

"Teacher," they said, "where are You staying?"

"Come with Me and you will see," Jesus replied. So they went with Him and stayed until about four o'clock in the afternoon.

One of the disciples who followed Jesus was named Andrew. Andrew went to find his brother, Simon. He told Simon to come with him because they had found the Messiah (Jesus Christ, our Savior).

When Jesus saw Simon, He said, "You are Simon, son of John. You will be called Cephas (also known as Peter)."
