




# CONVERSATION

## Priscilla and Aquila

### ACTS 18:1-3,18-28

A man named Paul, who traveled to many places teaching people about Jesus, met a man and his wife in a town called Corinth. The man was named Aquila and his wife was Priscilla. Aquila and Priscilla were tentmakers. Paul was also a tentmaker. Paul lived with Priscilla and Aquila and he worked with them, making tents, while he stayed there.



In a place called Ephesus, Priscilla and Aquila met a man named Apollos. Apollos taught the Scriptures, but he didn't know as much about Jesus as Paul, Priscilla, and Aquila. So, Priscilla and Aquila taught Apollos more about God and about Jesus.

Apollos then traveled and taught more people about Jesus. Many of the people he taught became believers.
