


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CONVERSATION

Baby Moses

EXODUS 1:8-2:10

There was a pharaoh, the king of Egypt, who forced God's people, the Hebrews, to be his slaves. The king and his people were very mean to the Hebrews, and they wanted to kill all of the Hebrew babies who were boys.



The baby's sister watched the basket. She saw the king's daughter find the basket. The king's daughter opened the basket and saw the baby boy.

The baby's sister asked the king's daughter: "Would you like me to find a Hebrew woman to take care of the baby for you?" The king's daughter told her to do that. The sister brought the baby's mother to her. The king's daughter asked the mother to care for the baby and return him to her when he was older. The baby was named Moses.

WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE: Take care of your family. 1 Timothy 5:4

LIFE POINT: Family members can care for and protect one another.

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

Parents, today's Bible story taught that family members can care for and protect one another. Moses' mother hid baby Moses to protect him from Pharaoh, and Moses' sister, Miriam, cared for him when she offered to help Pharaoh's daughter find someone to care for the baby.
