




UNIT 1. SESSION 2

Angels Told Good News

MATTHEW 1:18-24; LUKE 1:26-45

God sent the angel Gabriel to a town in Nazareth to see a young woman named Mary.

The angel said to Mary, "The Lord is pleased with you." Mary wondered what the angel could mean.

"Do not be afraid," the angel said. "You will give birth to a son, and you are to name Him Jesus. He will be great."



"How can this happen?" Mary asked. The angel said, "This special baby

will be God's Son. Elizabeth, your relative (family member), is going to have a baby and she is old. Nothing is impossible for God!"

Mary said, "I will obey and do what God wants."
