

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CONVERSATION

Jesus Was Born

LUKE 2:1-20

During the time Mary was pregnant with Baby Jesus, the Roman emperor, Caesar Augustus, announced that everyone needed to return to his hometown to be counted. Because Joseph was a descendant of King David, Joseph and Mary left Nazareth and traveled to Bethlehem, the city of David.



The time came for Mary to have her baby. Mary and Joseph looked for a place for Mary to stay, but there was no room for them in the inn. So Mary and Joseph found a place where animals were kept. Mary had her baby, Jesus. She wrapped Him snugly in cloth and laid Him in a manger.

Outside the city shepherds were in the fields watching their sheep. Suddenly, an angel of the Lord stood before them! A bright light shone around the shepherds, and they were terrified! The angel said to them, "Don't be afraid! I have come to bring you good news. This news is for all people! Today a Savior, who is Messiah the Lord, was born for you in Bethlehem! You will find the baby wrapped snugly in cloth and lying in a manger."

Many angels appeared. They praised God and said, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace, good will to all men."

The angels left, and the shepherds immediately went to Bethlehem to find Baby Jesus. They found Mary, Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in a manger.
