



A Baby for Elizabeth


LUKE 1:5-25,57-80

Zechariah was a priest who served in the temple, and his wife was named Elizabeth. God knew that Zechariah and Elizabeth obeyed His commandments. They were both old and did not have any children.

Zechariah was serving in the temple when an angel visited him. Zechariah was afraid, but the angel said: "Do not be afraid." The angel was sent by God to tell Zechariah that Elizabeth would have a baby boy named John. The baby was going to be special and do great things for God. Zechariah did not believe God's message delivered by the angel, so the angel said Zechariah would not be able to talk until the baby was born.

After several months, the baby was born. Elizabeth's neighbors and friends were happy for her and they wanted to know what the baby's name would be. They thought the baby should be named Zechariah, the same name as his father. But Zechariah wrote on a writing tablet that the baby's name would be John, just as the angel had said. Suddenly, Zechariah was able to talk again and he began to praise God. Everyone believed that John was a special baby.

God told Zechariah to tell everyone that when John grew up to be a man, he would announce that God's Son is coming. God sent John as part of His plan to tell people about His Son, Jesus.


