





## Paul Wrote to Timothy

#### ACTS 16:1-4; 2 TIMOTHY 1:1-5; 3:14-17

Paul chose a young man named
Timothy to travel with him and to
help teach people about Jesus.
Timothy was taught about God
by his mother, Eunice, and his
grandmother, Lois. The believers
thought that Timothy was a
special young man, and he would
be able to help Paul teach about Jesus.



"Timothy, you are like a son to me. I pray for you constantly. I thank God for your mother and grandmother, who taught you to be a faithful believer."

"Continue to believe in everything you were taught from the Bible and about Jesus. Remember everything you were taught by your mother and grandmother. Remember that the Bible is from God and is used to teach and train people. It is also used to help people make right choices. Follow what the Bible says, just as you have done since you were a young boy."

**WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE:** Go and tell the good news about Jesus. Mark 16:15
