Jesus Healed Bartimaeus

MARK 10:46-52

Jesus and His disciples had been in Jericho. As Jesus and His disciples were leaving Jericho with a large crowd, a blind man (a person who could not see) named Bartimaeus was sitting by the road. When Bartimaeus heard that Jesus was walking by, Bartimaeus called to Him. “Jesus, help me!” he cried.

Many people nearby told Bartimaeus to be quiet. But Bartimaeus kept calling out for Jesus to help him.

Jesus stopped and said, “Call him.” The people told Bartimaeus to get up, Jesus was calling him. Bartimaeus jumped up and hurried to Jesus.

“What do you want me to do for you?” asked Jesus.

The blind man said, “Teacher, I want You to make me able to see.”

Jesus told Bartimaeus, “Go. Your faith has made you well.”

Immediately Bartimaeus could see. He was happy and followed Jesus on His way.

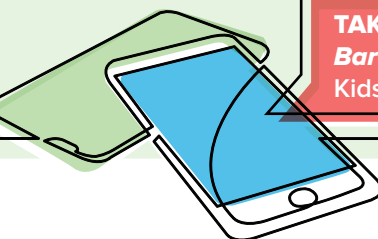
