

CONVERSATION

Jesus Chose Disciples


MARK 1:16-20; 2:13-14; 3:13-19

As Jesus walked by the Sea of Galilee, He saw two fishermen, Simon (Peter) and his brother, Andrew, casting their nets into the water.

"Follow Me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fish for people!" Immediately, the brothers left their nets to follow Jesus.

Jesus walked a little farther. He saw James and his brother, John, fixing their nets. They were sitting in a boat

with their father, Zebedee. Jesus called to the two brothers, and immediately, they left their father and their nets and followed Him.



Jesus called twelve men to be His disciples. Their job was to learn from Jesus, help Him, and go out and preach.

Jesus gave Simon a nickname: Peter. Jesus gave James and John a nickname, too: the Sons of Thunder.

Andrew, Philip, and Bartholomew followed Jesus. So did Matthew, Thomas, James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus. Another Simon called the Zealot followed Jesus, along with Judas, who later was not loyal to Jesus.
