


Jesus Chose Disciples

MARK 1:16-20; 2:13-14; 3:13-19

Jesus was walking alongside the Sea of Galilee. He saw two brothers, Simon and Andrew, who were fishermen. They were casting their net to catch fish. Jesus said, "Follow Me." Immediately, the brothers followed Jesus.

Jesus, Andrew, and Simon walked a little further. Jesus saw two other brothers, James and John. They were also fishermen. They were catching fish with their father. Jesus called James and John and told them to follow



Him. James and John left their fishing nets and followed Jesus. Four fishermen followed Jesus. The men helped Jesus.

Jesus chose other special men to help Him. He chose Levi (also known as Matthew). He chose Philip, Bartholomew, and Thomas. He also called James (son of Alphaeus), Thaddaeus, Simon the Zealot, and Judas Iscariot.

Jesus told Simon that his name would now be Peter. Jesus told the men that they were His disciples (helpers). They would learn about God. They would obey Jesus and help others because of God's power.
