Jesus Is Alive

JOHN 20:1-18

Jesus had died on the cross and was placed in a tomb.

Early in the morning, on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb where Jesus was buried. When she saw that the stone had been removed from the tomb, she ran to tell Peter and John.

“They’ve taken Jesus out of the tomb, and we don’t know where they put Him!”

Peter and John went to the tomb. Peter went in the tomb and saw the linen cloths that had been on Jesus’ body. John also went inside the tomb. Peter and John did not understand that Jesus would not stay in the tomb. They decided to go back home.

Mary was crying at the tomb. As she stooped to look inside, Mary saw two angels. They asked her: “Why are you crying?” Mary said: “They have taken Jesus away, and I don’t know where they put Him.” Mary turned around and saw Jesus, but she did not know it was Him.

Jesus said to her: “Why are you crying? Who are you looking for?” Mary answered: “Tell me where you put Him and I will take Him away.” Jesus said: “Mary.” Mary then knew that it was Jesus talking to her. Jesus wanted her to tell the disciples that He was going back to heaven.

Mary went and told the disciples: “I have seen Jesus!” She also told them what Jesus had said to her.

LIVE IT OUT

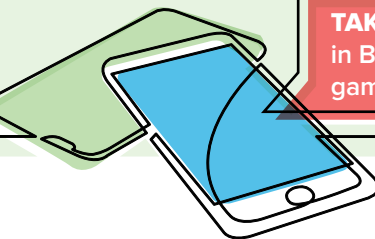
