# CONVERSATION

Josiah Learned from the Lost Scroll

#### 2 KINGS 22:1-23:3

Josiah became king of Judah when he was only eight years old. He was a good king. He chose to obey God and do right things.

When Josiah was a man, he sent a message to the priest at the temple: "Tell Hilkiah to take money from the offerings and pay workmen to repair the temple."



When the men were working, Hilkiah found a scroll. Hilkiah gave the scroll to the king's man and said, "We found a scroll, a book of God's laws."

The king's man took the scroll to Josiah, the king, and read the scroll to him.

Josiah became upset. He knew the people had not been doing what the scroll said to do. Josiah sent men to Huldah, the prophetess.

Huldah said, "Bad things will happen because the people have not obeyed. But Josiah has chosen what is right. The bad things will happen only after Josiah dies."

The king went to the temple. He gathered the people. He read the scroll. King Josiah made a promise to God and the people. He promised he would follow God and obey His commands. Then people said they would obey God, too.
