

# Jeremiah Wrote God's Words

#### **JEREMIAH 36**

Jeremiah was a prophet who told the people what God wanted them to know. One day, God spoke to Jeremiah and said: "Get a scroll. Write the words I have spoken to you."

Jeremiah sent for his helper Baruch. Jeremiah told Baruch the words and Baruch wrote the words on a scroll. God wanted the people to stop doing bad things and start doing right things.



"Take the scroll to the temple," Jeremiah told Baruch. "Read the words to the people."

Baruch took the Bible scroll and read the words to the people. Some of the king's helpers heard the words of the scroll. They told Baruch and Jeremiah to go and hide from the king.


The king's helpers read the words of the scroll to him. The king did not like the words he heard read from the scroll. He cut the scroll into pieces and threw the pieces in a fire.

God spoke to Jeremiah again. God said: "Get another scroll. Write the words again on the new scroll. The king has burned up the first scroll."

Jeremiah got another scroll and told Baruch to write the words again. Baruch wrote the words that were on the first scroll. God told Jeremiah more words to write, and Baruch added those words to the Bible scroll.
