### The Antioch Church Helped

#### **ACTS 11:19-30**

People were helping to tell the good news about Jesus in many places. In Antioch, people believed that Jesus is God's Son.

Some church leaders in
Jerusalem sent a man named
Barnabas to Antioch to meet the
people in the church. Barnabas
was a good man who loved Jesus,
and he helped to encourage the people

in Antioch to love Jesus. More and more people learned about Jesus.

Barnabas also traveled to Tarsus to find a man named Saul. Barnabas wanted Saul to go to Antioch, too. Barnabas and Saul taught the people more about Jesus. People who believed in Jesus were first called *Christians* at the church in Antioch.

A prophet (a man who told God's messages) named Agabus came to Antioch. He told that God said there would be a famine (a time of not having enough food) in Judea. The people in the church at Antioch sent help to the churches in Judea because the famine was coming.
