
CONVERSATION

Samuel in the Tabernacle

1 SAMUEL 1:24-28; 2:18-26; 3

Samuel's mother prayed for Samuel before he was born. In her prayer she wanted Samuel to work for God. Samuel was a very young boy when his mother took him to the tabernacle in Shiloh.

Samuel's mother came to see him every year and brought him a new robe when she would visit. Samuel continued to grow, and God was pleased with him. The people of Israel also liked Samuel.



Samuel became a prophet and told the people what God wanted them to know. He continued to grow and learn about God. All the people knew that Samuel was a prophet because he said God's words.
