
Samson Chose Revenge

JUDGES 13-16

God chose Samson before he was born to serve God. Because he was a Nazirite, Samson could not cut his hair. Samson grew and God blessed him. But Samson chose to do things that displeased God.

Samson loved a Philistine woman named Delilah. The Philistines promised to pay her

a lot of money if she could get Samson



Samson was captured by the Philistines. They made him blind. They put him in shackles and used him to grind their grain. Samson's hair began to grow back. While celebrating his capture, the Philistines brought him from prison to entertain them. They stood Samson between the great pillars of the temple. Samson asked God to give him strength one more time. God gave Samson strength and he pushed on the pillars with all of his might. The temple collapsed and killed Samson and all of the people in it.
