Joshua and Caleb

NUMBERS 13-14

God promised the people of Israel a new home in the land of Canaan. God told Moses to choose 12 men to go look at the land. Joshua and Caleb were 2 of the men.

"Go see if the people are strong or weak. See if the towns have high walls around them. See if the land is good for growing food," Moses told the men. "Bring back some of the fruit from the land."

The men obeyed God and traveled to Canaan. They looked at many of the towns and gathered fruit from the land. They cut a branch with a large bunch of grapes and also brought figs and pomegranates.

When the men came back, they reported: "The land is good for growing food." The men showed the people the fruit. Some of the men said, "The people who live in Canaan are bigger and stronger than we are. The towns have tall walls around them." But Caleb said, "We should go and take the land. God will be with us." Only Joshua and Caleb believed God's promises that they could take the land.

The people became frightened. They refused to go into the land. God was angry because they disobeyed. God still cared for the people, but they had to wander 40 years before going into the land. Only Caleb and Joshua would enter Canaan because they had trusted God.
